

Six A5 lined notebooks with a cover dedicated to views of the town.

The color view of the 'Enzo and Dino Ferrari' racetrack and the main entrance to the Sforza fortress are those of present-day Imola.

Made from photographs and historical postcards of the town, the notebooks with the town hall seen from the portico of the "Riario Sersanti" palace, the Montanara gate and a portion of the demolished walls of the town, "Caduti per la Libertà" (Those who gave their lives for Freedom) square, taken from below the town hall clock, and finally Gramsci square with the ancient market.
