For those whose hobby is collecting postcards and "Greetings from Imola" sent with a stamp, there are 18 views that are more or less typical of the town, on sale for $\notin 0,50$ each.

... for motor-loving tourists

Dedicated to the 'Enzo and Dino Ferrari' racetrack and its history, there are six views, among them one portrays the Grand Prix of Formula 1, one is made up of four shots of the track during competitions, another one is a memory of Ayrton Senna

... for cultural tourists

There are four postcards dedicated to the municipal museums (Museo San Domenico, Palazzo Tozzoni and Rocca Sforzesca).

... for stage lovers

The "Ebe Stignani Theater" is a nineteenth-century building with beautiful decorations in the boxes and in the "Ridotto" hall ... three postcards that show its splendor

... for those who enjoy experiencing the town

A picture of the main hall of the Municipal Library with its ancient texts, and one of the red room in the town hall, where people from Imola celebrate their civil marriages and an enchanting reflection of Porta Montanara

... for those in search of pictures from the past

There are people who love 'vintage' pictures and who are looking for traces of the past in the present ... here is a picture of a building that no longer exists in Gramsci square, a view of Matteotti place as it was and as it is today and the Montanara gate at the beginning of the twentieth century
